



# SVCC Service Changes (March 30<sup>th</sup>)

The MTS Board of Directors approved retaining a portion of SVCC services. The new services will start Monday, March 30, 2009.

Please refer to the list and map below to determine how you may be affected:

**UPCOMING SVCC SERVICE CHANGES**

- Route 89** Will be retained.
- Route 971** Will be combined with Route 972. All current stops will still be served. The AM trips may take a few minutes longer due to added service along Morehouse Drive & Barnes Canyon Road.
- Route 972** Will be combined with Route 971. All current stops will still be served. The PM trips may take a few minutes longer due to added service along Pacific Mesa & Pacific Center.
- Route 973** Will be combined with Route 974. Trips may take a few minutes longer due to added service along Nancy Ridge Road & Carroll Park Drive. The route will no longer serve the following streets:
  - **Cornerstone Court** – Will no longer deviate onto Cornerstone Court. There will be a stop at the intersection of Pacific Heights Blvd. & Cornerstone Court.
  - **Scranton Road** – Will now serve Younstown Way, instead of Scranton Road. A bus stop will be located at the intersection of Mira Mesa Road & Scranton Road. Route 971/972 will provide service to Morehouse Drive and Scranton Road.
  - **Scripps Pacific Sorrento Technology Park** – All passengers will now be picked up and dropped off along Sorrento Valley Road.
- Route 974** Will be combined with Route 973. All current stops will still be served, though in a clockwise direction rather than counter-clockwise direction. Trips may take a few minutes longer due to added service along Pacific Heights Blvd. and Oberlin Drive.
- Route 975** Will be discontinued. Some passengers may be able to use the Route 973/974 stop near Nancy Ridge Dr. & Carroll Rd.
- Route 976** Will be discontinued. Some passengers may be able to use the Route 89 stop at Genesee Ave. & Campus Point Drive.
- Route 977** Will be discontinued. A stop will be added on Route 978 at Science Center Drive. Route 978 will also stop on North Torrey Pines Road, just north of Genesee Ave.
- Route 978** Will be retained, with an additional stop located on Science Center Drive.

All trips before 6:30 a.m. will be discontinued. All other trips will still be designed to meet Coaster southbound arrival times in the morning, and northbound departure times in the afternoon. In order to save the service, many routes had to be combined. This may result in slightly earlier drop-off times in the afternoon, and occasionally waiting a couple minutes for a bus to arrive in the morning.

Updated timetables will be provided at least two weeks before the schedules change.
